**Subject:** Corrigendum to Guidelines on admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Year of degree level Eng. & Tech. including Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the academic session 2011-2012.

**Reference:** Our earlier letter vide no. 251/Edn(T)/10M – 74/09 dated 23.06.2011.

In partial modification to our earlier letter under above reference and on the subject mentioned therein, underneath please find the corrections which should be taken into consideration during the ensuing Counseling Process to be conducted by the Central Selection Committee {CSC (E&T)}.

The *Eligibility Criteria* in the aforementioned letter {refer para 1 (iv) and para 5 (xii) (c)} may please be replaced with the following;

- I. For all the Courses except B.Arch., Marine Engineering and B. Pharmacy:* General candidates must pass H.S. (10+2) or its equivalent examination, with a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together (45% for SC/ST candidates) (as per AICTE norms) and with at least 30% marks in English (for all category of candidates) with individual pass marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English and Vernacular (or any fifth subject);
- II. For Marine Engineering Course:* The minimum percentage of marks is 60% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together in (10+2) level with at least 50% marks in English either in 10<sup>th</sup> or in 12<sup>th</sup> Standard and with individual pass mark in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English and Vernacular (or any other fifth subject) for all category of candidates;
- III. For B. Pharm Course:*
  - i). For Institutions other than Jadavpur University:* General candidates must pass H.S. (10+2) or its equivalent examination with a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics/Biology, English and Vernacular (or any other fifth subject) for all category of candidates;
  - ii). For Jadavpur University:* General candidates must pass H.S. (10+2) or its equivalent examination with a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together (45% for SC/ST candidates) and with at least 30% marks in English and having individual pass marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English and Vernacular (or any other fifth subject) for all category of candidates;
- IV. For B.Arch. Course:* A candidate, besides satisfying the eligibility criteria as stated in (a) (I) above, have to qualify in the NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) conducted by the Council of Architecture, New Delhi.

Furthermore, the *selection of suitable candidates based on inter-se-merit*, under *Monitored Decentralised Counseling* {refer para 5 (xii) (c)} for non-JEM-2011 and non-AIEEE-2011 listed candidates, *inter-se merit would be decided on percentage of marks secured by candidates in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics or Physics, Chemistry & Biology in the 10+2 examination, taken together;* as the case may be.

Moreover, in para 6 **Management Quota**, line 7 would read **securing at least 50% marks in those subjects taken together and following norms laid down against para 5(x) & 5(xii)** in place of the existing line while in para 5 (vi) line 1, the number 5,0,000 would read **5,00,000**.
