**Proceeding of the Meeting on NVD held in the chamber of
District Election Officer on 22-12-2011 at 3.00 PM**

The meeting was presided over by the District Election Officer . He discussed elaborately the programmes on National Voter's Day which would be celebrated on 25th January 2012. It was decided in the meeting that the competition on Quiz, Debate and Essay Writing would be held Assembly Constituency wise at a central place which would be a Higher Secondary School within the constituency. The competition would be among the students of XIth and XIIth standard only. Each Higher Secondary School within the jurisdiction of the Assembly Constituency would send competitors separately for each Event. The number of competitors for each event per school are as follow.

- 1) Quiz : One team of two members
- 2) Debate : Two members , one for and the other against the motion.
- 3) Essay Writing : Two members .

The competition would be held on 16th January 2012 uniformly in all four Assembly Constituencies. The venue and Judges for the competition would be selected by District Inspector of School, Secondary. It was also resolved that the First and Second among the Competitors would qualify in the District Level Competition which would be held on 19th January 2012 at the place to be decided in the next meeting of the NVD Committee.


Simultaneously the College level competition among the First and Second year students would be held in the same pattern as would be organized in the school level. The date for college level competition would be also 16th January 2012. The first and second would qualify in the district level to be held on 19th January 2012. The Director of Public Instruction , Department of Higher Education , Bikash Bhavan Kolkata would be requested for his co-operation to organize the competition in college level.

Both in School and college level, in the debate competition the time allotted to each Competitor will be five minutes and in Essay writing it is 2.00 hours. The essay should be of 1500 words and the topic is "**PARTICIPATION OF YOUTH IN ELECTORAL PROCESS**".

The topic of the debate competition is "**IN THE OPINION OF THE HOUSE THE ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA CAN ENSURE FREE AND FAIR ELECTION.**"

There was no other issue for discussion. The meeting ended with thanks.
