Sub : Guideline for admission to Engineering & Technology Colleges including Pharmacy Colleges of this State for the academic session 2010-2011.

In continuation to this Department's Memo No. 354-Edn(T) 10M-74/09 dated 25/06/2010 the undersigned is directed to communicate the following guidelines for admission of Students in the seats in the degree level Engineering & Technology Colleges including Pharmacy Colleges of the State after 2nd Phase of Counseling.

1. Further merit list of JEM-2010 has been published by the WBJEE Board from the merit rank of 60,001 to 80,000 and 3rd Phase of Counseling will be held for allotment of Seats amongst these merit listed candidates in earliest convenient date with information to all concerned by CSC (E&T).
2. The absentee Students of the First Phase of Counseling as well as of the 2nd Phase of Counseling from the merit list of JEM-2010 (up to rank 60,000) and AIEEE-2010 (up to All India Rank 5 Lakh) will also be considered for 3rd Phase of Counseling. For this purpose all Private Self-financing Engineering and Technology Colleges will be required to submit report regarding admission against Management Quota to the WBUT for registration of Students by 27th August, 2010.
3. The Candidates shall have to adhere to the cut-off marks in qualifying examination (10+2) i.e. at least 50% (40% for SC/ST Candidates) marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (in aggregate) for Engineering and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics or Biology (in aggregate) for Pharmacy as well as pass marks in each individual subject and pass marks (30%) in English.

4. Vacant seats under Management Quota, if there be any, can be filled up with JEM merit listed candidates up to 80,000 merit rank. Other eligibility criteria will remain same as mentioned under Memo No. 354-Edn(T) 10M-74/09 dated 25/06/2010.
5. West Bengal University of Technology will be required to extend the last date of admission beyond 30th August, 2010.

All concerned may be informed accordingly.
