Sub : Admission of students in JIS College of Engineering, a minority Institution in  
West Bengal

The undersigned is directed to say that following discussions with Sri Taranjit Singh, Managing Director, Sri Ujjal Chakrabarty, Sr. Administrator and Sri Anil Sribastav, Law Officer of JIS Group Educational Initiatives on 14.06.2010, procedure as mentioned hereunder in respect of admission of students in JIS College of Engineering, a minority Institution for religious minority of Sikh religion in West Bengal, will be followed for Academic Session 2010-2011:

- i. 10% of sanctioned intake of students of the institution may be admitted by it under management quota following this Department's order no. 450-Edn (T) dated 24.06.2008.
- ii. (a) Out of the remaining seats, 50% of the seats will be earmarked for the students belonging to minority community. Admission to such minority quota will be done on the basis of inter se merit in WBJEE / AIEEE Examination of the said minority students through centralized counseling conducted by the Central Selection Committee (Engineering and Technology). If some seats remain vacant within minority quota after first phase of counseling and the institute feels that they are likely to remain vacant even after subsequent phase (s) of counseling, the institute may approach CSC (E&T) to fill up the remaining seats from

general category candidates on the basis of rank in WBJEE / AIEEE Examination. This request to CSC (E&T) should be made within 27.07.2010 which is the due date for giving information on number of vacant seats to the CSC (E&T) before second phase of counseling.

- (b) The admission to remaining 50% of the seats will be done on the basis of inter se merit of general students in WBJEE / AIEEE Examination through centralized counseling conducted by the CSC (E&T).
  
- iii. This is issued in partial modification of the guidelines on admission to Engineering and Technology including Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the academic session 2010-2011, issued vide this office Memo no.354-Edn (T) 10M-74/09 dated 25.06.2010. All other aspects of the aforesaid guidelines, not modified by present Memo, will continue to apply, to JIS College of Engineering.

The letter no. Nil dated 14.06.2010 issued by the Managing Trustee of JIS Foundation requesting, *inter alia*, “admission of students to minority quota through a special admission test to be conducted by the College for those students” has been received on 15.06.2010 (next day of meeting on 14.06.2010) and is being examined for legal implications in the light of policy regulations of AICTE, guidelines of National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, Government of India and the Hon’ble Supreme Court’s rulings in similar cases. Action as needed after such examination will be taken, under intimation to the institution.

Necessary action may be taken accordingly.
