**Sub : Guidelines on admission to Engineering & Technology including Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the academic session 2010-2011.**

With reference to the above subject the undersigned is directed to communicate the following guidelines for admission of students in the degree level Engineering & Technology, including Pharmacy Colleges of the State under the purview of this Department:

**1. Entrance Examination and Basic Criteria :**

- i) **Universities / Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges:** 100% seats will be filled up with the Engineering Merit List of the Joint Entrance Examination for admission to Engineering, Medical and Dental Colleges (JEM).
- ii) **Private self-financing Colleges:** Out of total AICTE approved seats, 80% from JEM, 10% from All India Engineering Entrance Examination (AIEEE) and 10% from Management Quota will be filled up.
- iii) **Domicile criteria:** There shall be no domicile requirement for Universities / Private Self-financing Engineering & Technology colleges, but for allotment in Government Engineering & Technology Colleges, candidates domiciled in the State of W.B. shall only be considered. **For selection and allotment of students under the reserved category (SC/ST), candidates domiciled in the State of W.B. shall be considered only.**
- iii) **Other eligibility criteria :** Both JEM and AIEEE merit listed candidates shall have to adhere to the cut-off marks in qualifying exam (10+2) i.e., at least 50% (40% for SC/ST candidates) marks in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics (in aggregate) as well as pass marks in each individual subjects and pass marks (30%) in English.

- 2. Publication of merit list for JEM and cut-off marks for AIEEE:** West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB) has published a merit list upto 60,000 (general candidates) and corresponding list for SC/ST candidates (for the State only) and physically challenged (PC)

candidates for Engineering & Technology courses. This full merit list of JEM upto a rank of 60,000 including the corresponding merit list for reserved candidates and AIEEE merit list up to the rank 5 lakh (All India Rank) will be considered for admission in 2010-2011.

3. **Preparation of Seat Matrix :** Director of Technical Education (DTE), West Bengal shall, on behalf of Government of West Bengal, prepare the Seat Matrix for 2010-2011 in the following manner : -

- i) Existing institutions / new institutions receiving AICTE's extension of approval / approval appearing in their website **within 30.06.2010** and West Bengal University of Technology's (WBUT) extension of affiliation / affiliation **within 30.06.2010** shall be taken into consideration for inclusion in the counseling process for the academic year 2010-2011 as per existing AICTE guidelines. West Bengal University of Technology (WBUT) will provide information about affiliation to DTE, West Bengal by **01.07. 2010**.
- ii) All Private Self-financing Engineering & Technology Colleges who want to implement Management Quota (as laid down in para 5) will have to intimate DTE by **30.06.2010** so that the same can be reflected in the seat matrix. Subsequent information regarding dropout / vacant seats against Management Quota shall be sent by such colleges to the Central Selection Committee (Engineering & Technology), hereinafter called CSC (E&T), with copies to DTE and WBUT within **27.07.2010**. Such information will be required by CSC (E&T), DTE and WBUT prior to second phase and any subsequent phase of counseling. Final report about all such admissions shall be given by colleges to CSC (E&T), DTE and WBUT by **16.08.2010**.
- iii) The complete Seat Matrix, with SC / ST / PC / any other category break up for all Universities / Govt. Colleges / Aided / Self-financed / Private Colleges and other details shall reach the CSC (E&T) by **02.07. 2010**.
- iv) Reservation of seats for SC/ST/PC candidates shall be made as per State Govt. norms for all the Govt. Engineering & Technology colleges as well as for Self-financing Engineering & Technology Colleges who have received some grants for the Govt.
- v) Defence Quota, DTE's Quota for other states, shall be indicated in the Seat Matrix as per the standard procedure.

4. **Counseling programme for allotment of candidates for admission to the institutes /courses:**

Counseling shall be conducted in 2 (two) phases by the CSC (E&T), in the following manner:

- i) **The first phase of counseling** will take place from **03.07. 2010** and likely to continue up to **20.07. 2010**. In 1<sup>st</sup> phase of counseling upto 60,000 candidates for the JEM, 2010 and 5,00,000 candidates for AIEEE appearing in the merit lists will be considered. Respective Institutions (Colleges & Universities) shall complete admission formalities for the candidates allotted through 1<sup>st</sup> phase of counseling and communicate complete admission position [containing information about approved seat capacity, no. of candidates allocated by CSC(E&T) through 1<sup>st</sup> phase of

counseling, no. of candidates admitted against allocated candidates in 1<sup>st</sup> phase of counseling, any vacancies created due to drop-out of allotted /admitted candidates, net vacancies due to primary or dropout vacancy and surrendering of any seat against management quota] by **27.07. 2010** to CSC (E&T). Such position will have to be provided discipline-wise, including reserved categories.

A candidate reporting at the counseling centre seeking allotment of seat, shall have the option to register himself as a **wait-listed** candidate with a serial number for next phase of counseling, in case he / she does not opt for admission in any seat in any college available to him/her as per merit during the current phase of counseling. Such option will have to be exercised at the time of counseling itself.

- ii) CSC (E&T) will allocate students to different colleges based on their merit and choice as per provisions laid down in this Memorandum.
- iii) **The second phase of counseling** will take place **from 30.07.2010 to 01.08. 2010** where the wait-listed candidates out of the first phase of counseling will be offered seats against the primary or drop-out vacancy and seats against surrendering of management quota, if any.

In case the first phase counseling ends with a merit list below 60,000 (say 40,000) then second phase counseling will be based on wait listed candidates of the 1<sup>st</sup> phase after which the remaining candidates from 40,001 to 60,000 will be asked to exercise option.

Respective Institutions shall complete admission formalities of the allotted candidates through second phase of counseling and communicate detailed admission positions with information on net vacant seats.

But while reporting net vacant seats available at this stage, cumulative vacancies have to be reported to the CSC (E&T) **by 16.08. 2010**. The format to be used will contain the information, namely, net vacancies after first phase as reported, number of candidates allocated by CSC (E&T) through second phase, number of candidates admitted against allocated candidates in second phase, number of vacancies created due to dropout of candidates admitted in current and preceding phase, net vacancies due to dropout and non-admission and any other relevant information.

- iv) **If seats remain vacant even after second phase of counseling** in Engineering and Technology, the method of filling up of the seats will be decided afterwards.
- v) **Venue for counseling will be separately notified by the CSC (E&T).**

**5. Management Quota:** Private Self-Financing Colleges shall be allowed to fill upto a maximum of 10% of seats within the merit ranks (JEM – upto 60,000; **AIEEE – merit listed candidates within the published AIEEE rank 2010**) subject to fulfillment of usual terms and conditions as laid down in G.O. No.450-Edn (T) dated 24.06. 2008. Further, for the academic session 2009 - 2010 and 2010

- 2011, the Management Quota seats for those institutions, which are impacted by Hon'ble Supreme Court's order dated 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2009 in the SLP No. 1871 of 2009 along with other connected Civil Appeals, will be reduced from above-mentioned quota as per Hon'ble Court's Order. This reduction will be reflected in the seat-matrix to be prepared by the DTE.

- 6. Filling up of seats for B. Pharm. :** Pharmacy seats in self-financing Pharmacy Colleges shall be filled up with the merit listed candidates of JEM / AIEEE within the specified merit rank, with either of the combination of subjects Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM) / Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB). The method of filling up vacant seats for B. Pharm. will be decided after the 2 (two) phases of counseling are over.
- 7. Admission in B. Arch. Course:** For admission to 5 years B. Arch. Course, the clearance of National Aptitude Test for Architecture (NATA) shall be fulfilled as per the guidelines published by the Council of Architecture. The name of the candidate shall also appear in the merit rank of JEM. The National Aptitude Test for Architecture (NATA) will be conducted as per guidelines published by the Council of Architecture.
