**Sub: Guidelines on granting concessions to the wards of Kashmiri Migrants in the matter of their admission to the Educational Institutions in the State of West Bengal during the academic session 2010 – 2011.**

**Ref: Circular No. AICTE / PC / KASH – MIG / 2010-11 dated 26.05.2010 of All India Council For Technical Education.**

With reference to the above subject the undersigned is directed to communicate the following guidelines for admission of the wards of Kashmiri Migrants in the degree level Engineering & Technology, including Pharmacy Colleges of the State under the purview of this Department:

- i) **Extension in date of admission by about 30 days:** The State Government extends the date of admission for Kashmiri Migrants till 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2010.
- ii) **Relaxation in Cut-off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement:** For Kashmiri Migrants the cut-off percentage is decreased by 10 % i.e. candidates must have to pass 10 + 2 with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together or Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together with 40 % marks subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- iii) **Increase in intake capacity up to 5 % Course-wise:** For Kashmiri Migrants course-wise intake capacity to be increased by 5 % on supernumerary basis.
- iv) **Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in Technical/Professional Institutes:** one seat on merit quota in each discipline to be allotted to Kashmiri Migrants in Government Engineering & Technology Colleges which may be converted to general seat if not fulfilled by Kashmiri Migrant.

- v) **Waiving of domicile requirements:** In respect of allotment of seats for Kashmiri Migrants in Government Engineering & Technology Colleges, domicile requirements will be waived.
- vi) **Facilitation and Migration in second and subsequent years:** Migration in second year will be allowed for lateral entry candidates.
