**Sub: Strict compliance with collection of authorized fees.**

Sir,


WHEREAS in terms of this Department's Memo. No.363-Edn(T) dated 30.6.2010, tuition fee and other fees, for new entrants to U.G. level Engineering & Technology Courses in private self-financing Engineering and Technology Colleges in the State of West Bengal from the academic session, had been stated to be Rs.55,000/- per annum and no separate development fee would be realized from the students.

2. Besides the aforementioned tuition fee, such Colleges may charge one time admission fee of Rs.4,000/- for the entire course at the time of admission, appropriate library fee, refundable caution money, any fee charged by the University for benefit and welfare of the students and other usual fees charged by the University like Registration fee, examination fee etc.
3. In terms of this Department's Memo. No.214-Edn(T) dated 03.6.2011, as an interim measure, the private self-financing Engineering and Technology Colleges have been allowed to collect a further amount of rs.15,000/- as tuition fee from each of the new entrants for academic session 2010-11 in addition to the earlier prescribed tuition fee of Rs.55,000/- subject to final determination of tuition fee for the session 2010-11 and subject to the condition that if finally determined tuition fee is less than Rs.70,000/- (Rs.15,000/- + Rs.55,000/-), the College will adjust excess amount against tuition fee payable for the next semester or year as the case may be. All other provisions as stipulated in this Department's Memo. vide No.363-Edn(T) dated 30.6.2010 will follow. Tuition fee to be collected for students admitted against the Management Quota has also been specified.

4. It has been reported that some of the private self-financing Engineering & Technology Colleges are collecting additional fees in excess of specified fees as mentioned in the mentioned Govt. orders in this regard without any money receipt (including that for students admitted against Management Quota).
5. Collection of such additional fees is unauthorized and will invite action as per law including possibility of de-affiliation/de-recognition.

All the private self-financing Engineering and Technology Colleges may be informed of this position and requested to furnish a detailed report on different fees, collected from the new entrants, to the Directorate immediately. The same may be compiled and submitted to this Department within 29<sup>th</sup> of July, 2011.


